


NATURE OF INCIDENT: Non-aggravated assault.

DATE OF INCIDENT: October 17, 2009.

LOCATION OF INCIDENT: The Regents Guest Area, which is located inside the Press Box of the Michigan football stadium, 1201 S. Main Street.

OFFICERS ON SCENE: N/A.

REPORT RECEIVED: Following the U of M vs. Delaware State football game, some of the students that DPS employ to work at the games, were in the Training Room of our station completing payroll sheets. The management of the student program is one of my responsibilities. I stopped in the room for a few minutes. One of the student employees asked if I recalled a conversation that she and I had during a hockey game we were both working on October 3, 2009. During part of that conversation, she had told me that someone had pushed her during one of her assignments. She did not identify the person involved and I told her that if it ever happened again, that she should notify me immediately. Turner told me that one of the student employees had been pushed during the U of M vs. Delaware State game. I asked her to talk with me in another room and Turner told me that DPS student employee Arif Khan was the victim and that the suspect was U of M Athletic Director Bill Martin. Both Turner and Khan were interviewed on October 18, 2009.

STATEMENT OF TURNER: Jackie Turner was interviewed at 1405 in the DPS Training Room. Sgt. Jan Connors assisted with the interview. Turner is currently an U of M student and is employed by DPS to work at special events. This is her second year working for DPS. Turner stated that she was assigned to the north stairwell in the Regents Guest Area. Her assignment consists mainly of making sure that only persons with a Regents Guest Area wristband are permitted into that area. After the game ended, she met with the other students who were also working the Regents Guest Area (Arif Khan, Julie Perry, Lauren Lacy and Amanda Hill). Turner said that it was about 1530. When she met with them, she said that they were all talking about an incident where someone had pushed by Kahn after the game had ended. Turner said that Khan referred to the incident several times while they were walking back to the police station. Turner said that she told Khan that he should inform someone about the incident. Turner said that when she saw me, she decided to report the incident.

Turner also provided more information about the incident that she was involved with during the first half of the U of M vs. Notre Dame football game on September 12, 2009. Turner said that during this game she was also assigned to the Regents guest area at the north glass doors. These doors lead from the Regents Guest Area to the general seating area of the stadium. Turner said that just before halftime, she opened the door for several people to exit. Turner said that after they went through the doors, three white males wearing white polo U of M polo shirts attempted to come through the doors into the Regents Guest Area. Turner said that she stepped into the doorway and told the one in front that she needed to see his pass to the area. Turner said that the person then put his right hand on

her left shoulder and said "honey, I am the Athletic Director". Turner said that he then pushed her on the left shoulder just hard enough to guide her out of his way. Turner said that she did not resist in anyway. Turner said that the person then proceeded as did the two other males that were with him and said that "we're just passing through". Turner said that the man who made physical contact with her was an elderly white male. After the male walked past her she made a gesture to one of the University Development Events staff members who was in the area to inquire if the male should be allowed in. Turner said that the staff member gestured back, indicating that it was OK. Turner said that she did not remember the name of the staff member, nor did she think that the staff member witnessed the incident. Turner did not report the incident at the time.

When asked, Turner said that she needed some time to decide whether or not to press charges.

STATEMENT OF KAHN: Arif Khan was interviewed at 1505 in the DPS Training Room. Sgt. Jan Conners assisted with the interview. Khan is currently an Eastern Michigan University student and is employed by DPS to work at special events. This is his second year working for DPS. Khan said that he was assigned to work the south stairwell during the U of M Delaware State game. He said that very shortly after the game ended, an elderly male and female came down the staircase and approached him at the door that leads into the Regents Guest Area. Khan said that initially the two started to walk past him as if he wasn't there. Kahn said that he then put his hand on the door and said that he needed to see their passes to enter the area. Kahn said that the male subject then became upset. Khan said that the male then used his right hand to forcibly grab Khan's windbreaker and gripped a large portion of Khan's DPS issued uniform windbreaker. The area gripped was over Khan's chest and pushed him slightly. Khan said the person then told him the "I am the Athletic Director, I can go in". Khan said that he could not go in without a pass and that he could get someone (University Development Events staff) to help you. Khan said that the male, who had released him, then grabbed Khan's identification badge, which was hanging on a lanyard around Khan's neck. Khan said that the male then said "I want to know your name". Khan said that the woman with him had an all access pass (which does not permit entry into the Regents Guest Area) did not say anything during the incident. Khan described the woman as about the same height of the male and had short hair. Khan said that a University Development Events staff member then identified the person as being the Athletic Director and allowed him to enter. Kahn said that he did not know the name of the staff member, but said that she always works there and would recognize her if he saw her.

When asked, Khan said that he needed some time to decide whether or not to press charges.

VICTIM INJURIES: No injuries were reported.

SUSPECT: William Carl Martin, white male, date of birth

LEIN/CCH INQUIRY: Martin returned with no warrants and a clear CCH.

INFORMATION: On 10/17/2009, two DPS student employees reported that they had assaulted by William Martin. The students are U of M student Jackie Turner and EMU student Arif Khan. At the time that the students were interviewed, both of them said that they needed time to decide whether or not to press charges.

INVESTIGATION: I called both Turner and Khan on 10/20/09. They said that they had talked to each other and did not want to pursue criminal charges against Martin. They also said that they hoped that there would be some follow up to the incident. Turner and Khan also said that they would be willing to meet with Martin if it was appropriate.

On 10/19/09, I received a return telephone call from Julie Perry, who was working in the general area when the incident occurred. Perry said that she did not see any portion of the incident and found out about it only when Khan told her about it.

I requested that my understanding and recollection be placed in the file on this matter. My normal routine on game days is to cut through the Regents Guest Area to get up to the Athletic Director's box, where I have a variety of hosting duties, and then at the end of the game I retrace my steps to get down to the field. For the previous eight seasons at Michigan Stadium, the entrance area to the RGA had a uniformed DPS/security person stationed who recognized me and let me pass through. I don't remember details of the interaction with an employee on 9/12, but on 10/17 Sally and I were stopped by a person who did not have the DPS regular blue uniform on. I identified myself as the Athletic Director and Sally showed him her all-access pass, but he said the all-access pass no longer allowed entry into the RGA. I was not aware the RGA security process had changed. It was a frustrating situation, and one I should have handled differently. Once I realized he was a DPS employee, Sally and I waited until he found a staff person who identified me. I have communicated with both employees to discuss the situation and express my regret. They were just doing their jobs.
