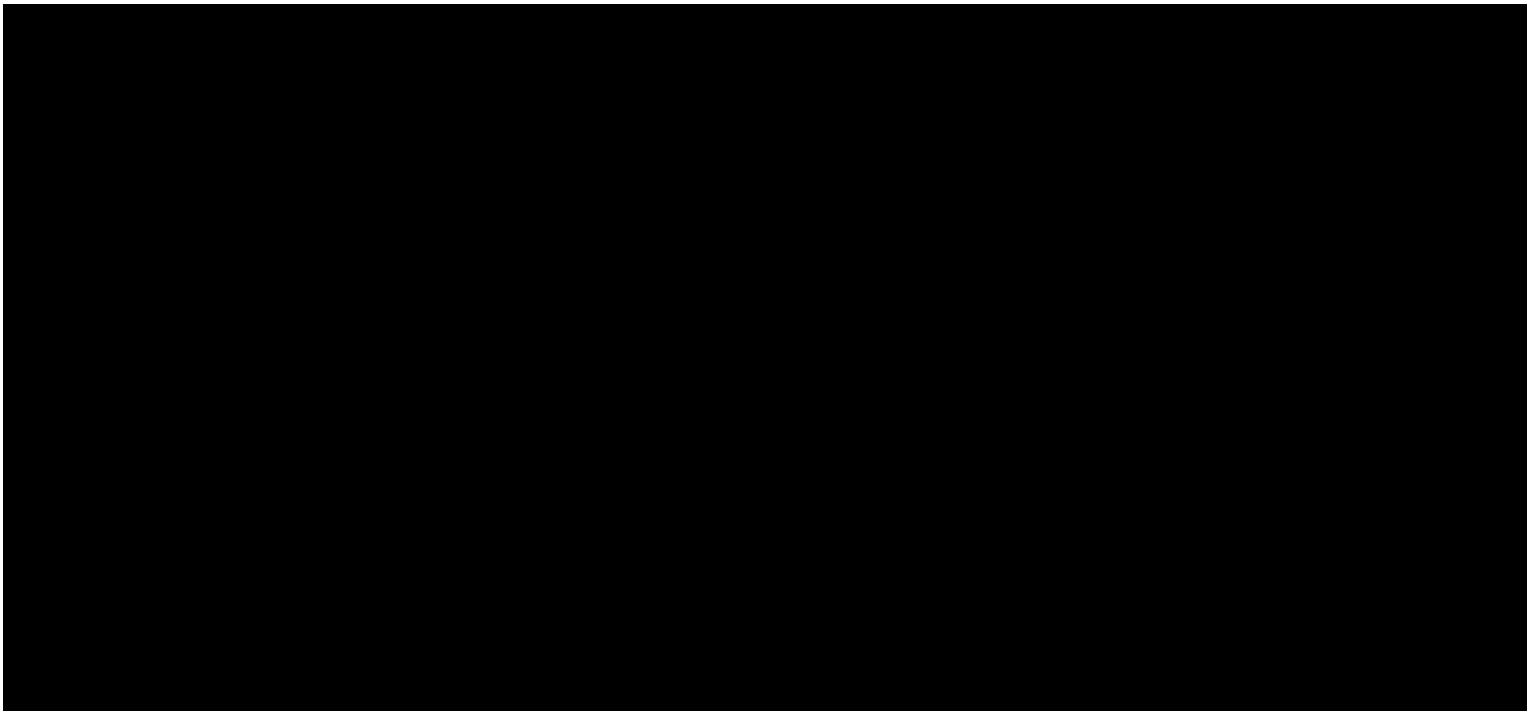

On Friday 11/30/07 at 0939 hrs, CCPD dispatch received a call from a resident in the sub-division of Trails of Willow Bend who advised of a green Honda occupied by five young black males was driving slowly through the area and parking in driveways.

Ofc Coppola and I arrived in the area and waited for other police units for an area canvass. (I was at the corner of WPB North & NW 55th Drive and Ofc Coppola was at the corner of WPB North & NW 56th Drive.) On NW 55th Drive, I was waived down by an older b/m near a black 335i BMW. He told me he just saw a green Honda driving in the area occupied by black males wearing gloves.

As other officers arrived in the area, CCPD dispatch advised on the police radio that an occupied burglary just took place at 5512 NW 41st Ave, which is within the Trails of Willow Bend sub-division. The resident/victim advised a FL tag for the Honda: I858PT

As I was establishing a perimeter, I was stationary in the 5400 block of Winston Park Blvd North and a green Honda Civic occupied by five young black males passed me. I made a quick u-turn, saw the attached FL tag matched and advised the same on the radio. Ofc Coppola was right in the area when I activated my overhead lights and siren to initiate traffic stop. The Honda stopped without incident and all were detained in handcuffs.

They were identified as the following: [REDACTED], adult driver from Ft Laud; [REDACTED] front passenger juvenile from Margate; [REDACTED] juvenile from Ft Laud; [REDACTED] adult from Ft Laud & Demar Dorsey, juvenile from Lauderdale Lakes. All but [REDACTED] (Coral Springs Charter) attend Boyd Anderson HS. All were truant.

I immediately advised all five subjects of their Miranda rights from a pre-printed card and each acknowledged separately that they understood.

Ofc C. Ku and Det. A. Hofer responded to the residence to meet with Paul [REDACTED] the resident at 5512 NW 41st Ave. A short time later, Det A. Hofer drove [REDACTED] to the scene of the traffic stop for a show up. [REDACTED] positively identified Demar and [REDACTED] as two of the black males he encountered in his living room. Paul never gave either of them permission to enter his home and gave a sworn taped statement to Det. A. Hofer about the incident.

Demar and [REDACTED] were then placed under arrest for burglary. Search incident to arrest with [REDACTED] two metal window punchers were found in his left sock. As the investigation continued at the scene of the traffic stop, numerous items were found in the trunk of the Honda that were believed to be stolen. There was information from Coral Springs PD that there was a residential burglary earlier in their city where a flat screen TV was taken. A flat screen TV was located in the trunk, along with other electronics. CSPD case # 07-10366.

Prior to bringing all five black males to the PD for further questioning, a pair of black cotton gloves were located stuffed in the baggy jeans of [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. At the PD, all five gave statements and/or confessions to their involvement in the occupied burglary of [REDACTED] residence.

Statements were taken by Ofc Ku and Det. A Hofer and placed into property as evidence. The Honda Civic was seized for forfeiture and taken to the PD in order to inventory the recovered property.

I placed the two window punches into property as evidence under # 1950. The black cotton gloves were placed into property as evidence under # 1951.

On 11/30/07 at approximately 0921 hours I responded to 56th Street and 40th Terrace reference to a suspicious vehicle. Dispatch advised the vehicle was a green Honda Civic occupied with five black males. The vehicle was seen driving slow in the area and pulling into multiple driveways.

I arrived in the area of Winston Park Blvd and Winston Park Blvd North. I held this location and was notified by dispatch that a black BMW occupied by three black males may also be involved. I observed a vehicle fitting this description coming south bound on Winston Park North. The black BMW was occupied by one black male driver. I followed the vehicle and initiated a traffic stop north bound on Lyons Road at approximately the 5600 block of Lyons Road. I asked for an additional patrol unit to back me up. Officer Barreto responded to back me up. I made contact with the driver and asked for his license, registration and proof of insurance. The driver was identified as [REDACTED], by his Florida drivers license. [REDACTED].

I explained to [REDACTED] why I stopped him and he was upset with me, stating he was not involved. He told me he was actually a witness and called the burglary into police. [REDACTED] then proceeded to described five black males in a green Honda Civic. He did not give much of a description, besides one of the males was wearing gloves and another had on a gray sweat shirt. After detaining [REDACTED] for several minutes and the vehicle containing only one black male instead of three black males as dispatch described, I released [REDACTED] from the scene. At this point, none of the units could identify [REDACTED] as a suspect. I asked him if he would assist the police and come identify the males he described and he agreed. [REDACTED] observed the males and stated those were the same five males he saw running between two homes in the area of Trails of Willow Bend. He then explained, he had to go to work and would give a tape statement later.

I then took pictures of the green Honda Civic and the items in the trunk. Located in the trunk of the vehicle were the following items: a medium sized silver colored flat screen television, a blue Toshiba lap top and a amplifier. Within the vehicle were several pairs of gloves, back packs and black ski mask. I also took pictures of the vehicle and the five black males that were in the Honda Civic. This disk was placed into evidence.

An audio recording from my unit was also taken into evidence. The tape contains audio conversations between two of the males we arrested. The tape was taken in as evidence and assigned property #07-1952 and placed in the felony locker.

On 11/30/07 at approximately 0945 hours, I responded to 5512 NW 41st Ave in reference to a Burglary that occurred while the residence was occupied.

Victim, [REDACTED], stated that someone was ringing the door bell to his residence this morning. As he got out of bed to check who was at the residence, he saw out of the window a black BMW backed into the driveway, and several black males walking around. He did not know who the males were so he did not answer the door. Shortly after, [REDACTED] heard noises from his living room. As he walked out to the living room, he was confronted by two (2) black males standing. The two suspects then fled out of the sliding door to the rear of the residence, ran out of the enclosed patio, and toward the front of the house.

Upon my arrival, [REDACTED] stated that he was in fear for his life and did not know what to do. I entered the residence from the front door, and immediately noticed shattered glass from the sliding door all over the floor and patio. Upon further investigation, the suspects then exited using the south patio door, and fled toward the front leaving behind one (1), black Nike slipper(Right).

I processed the sliding door, and patio door for latent fingerprints with no results. I then took pictures of the slipper and the entry points of which the suspects used. The slipper was placed into evidence (Property #07-1946).

On November 30, 2007, this officer assisted road patrol with an arrest of five individuals involved in the burglary to a residence. The suspect vehicle, a 2000 Honda Civic, green in color, Florida tag I858PT was towed from the scene to the PD. Upon arrival, this officer accepted the vehicle from the Driscolls Towing driver. The vehicle exterior and interior were photographed by this officer utilizing a digital camera. Several pieces of suspected evidence were also photographed. It should be noted case #2007-31929 was documented within the digital photographs. This case number is wrong and should be 2007-31925.

Detective Dingus assisted this officer with the documentation of the evidence. On the front passenger floor board was a "Nike" brand sandal that was removed under property #07-1947. The other half of the pair was found on the burglary scene. Property 07-1948 was assigned to a black ski mask, black cloth gloves, orange/gray football gloves, and a black backpack. These items were found on the rear seat. Property #07-1949 was assigned to a gray "Escort " brand GPS system with adaptor, which was found lying on the back seat. A Sylvania flat screen television and a blue Toshiba laptop with power cord were found in the trunk. A black Streamlight flashlight with case was found within one of the backpacks on the back seat. All the property was placed in the secured property/evidence room.

It was later learned that Coral Springs PD had received a residential burglary report (case #07-10366) on this date shortly after 0900 hours, in which the black male suspects had left the scene in a green vehicle. Taken from that residence was a Sylvania television. This officer made contact with Detective Walters of Coral Springs PD. Him and his victim, [REDACTED], arrived at this PD. [REDACTED] was shown the television and he positively identified it. He also provided the original owners manual that indicated the model number which matched the number on the television. [REDACTED] signed for and received the television. Walters will be providing a copy of their original burglary report and a copy of Mr. [REDACTED] taped statement.

The vehicle was taken in for possible forfeiture and will be handled by Detective Skirvin. As of December 03, 2007, the Toshiba laptop was clear NCIC/FCIC via serial number.

On 11/30/07, I assisted Detective Hofer with the interviews of each of the subjects arrested in this case. These interviews were conducted at the Coconut Creek Police Department and were DVD recorded from start to finish. Each of the subjects were advised of their respective Miranda Warnings and presented with a form of which they read and signed. Each of the subjects agreed to provide a taped statement relative to this incident. The following is a summary of each of their interviews.

Statement (1130 hours)- stated that he was contacted the previous day by at which time asked him if he wanted to go make some money. On this date drove his father's vehicle to a store in the area of Boyd Anderson High School and picked the rest of the subjects up. As only possesses a restricted drivers license, became the driver and drove the vehicle for the rest of the morning. They drove to the residence in Coconut Creek at which time backed the vehicle into the driveway. exited the vehicle and knocked on the front door while Dorsey, and went around the side of the house towards the back. states that as he was walking to back of the house the other 3 came running towards him yelling that somebody was home. As turned to run he left one of his Nike flip flops on the side of the house. Once inside the car states that and Dorsey both were observed with gloves on. Once the police attempted to pull them over, handed a center punch and told him to get rid of it. then concealed the center punch on his person.

Damar Dorsey Statement (1205 hours)-Dorsey stated that he was picked up by near Boyd Anderson High School and that became the driver of the vehicle. Dorsey observed walk up and knock on the front door of the residence in Coconut Creek. Dorsey, and walked around the back of the house to the rear glass slider. Dorsey states that at first he was the "lookout", but then did proceed into the house once the glass was broken. When they were confronted by the home owner they immediately fled from residence towards the vehicle. Dorsey admitted to wearing his football gloves during the incident.

Statement( 1245 hours)- initially stated that he was in the area of Coconut Creek High School when he was picked up by When they arrived at the residence in Coconut Creek, stated that he stayed in the vehicle and was text messaging a girl in Coral Springs. When confronted with what his friends were saying, agreed to tell the truth regarding his involvement. stated that at the Coconut Creek house he was at the rear of the house and was acting as the "lookout" while this was going on. adds that he believed had the center punch and he was standing on the patio near the screen door. Once he heard the home owner yell he immediately ran from the patio to the vehicle. remembers Dorsey, and as all being on the patio and having gone into the residence at the time the glass was broken.

then provided information regarding a stolen television that was found in the trunk of s vehicle. states that prior to going to the Coconut Creek residence they went to a residence in Coral Springs where backed the vehicle into the driveway. knocked on the door at which time there was no answer. Dorsey, and then walked around the back of the residence at which time an alarm began to sound. states he was acting as a lookout during this crime and was on the phone with Dorsey while they went around the back. They entered the vehicle with driving and began to leave the area. The realized they did not have

██████████ with them as they were leaving and at the same time they observed ██████████ jumping over a wall onto Wiles road with a TV in his possession.

██████████ Statement (1325 hours)- ██████████ was picked up with the other subjects in the area of Boyd Anderson High School. On arrival at the Coral Springs residence, ██████████ backed the vehicle into the driveway while ██████████ knocked on the front door. ██████████ Dorsey, ██████████ and ██████████ all walked around to the back of the residence. The rear slider was center punched at which time all 4 subjects entered the residence. ██████████ picked up the TV and fled the residence as they all began to run out.

On arrival at the Coconut Creek residence, ██████████ states that everyone went around back and he stayed by the screen door. Dorsey and ██████████ were both by the glass door when it was center punched. ██████████ was about to enter the residence when he heard the home owner yell. At the time he went into this house, ██████████ was not wearing gloves on his hands.

██████████ Statement (1355 hours)- ██████████ was picked up by ██████████ in the area of Boyd Anderson High School. At that time ██████████ drove ██████████'s vehicle as he has a regular drivers license. On arrival at the Coral Springs residence, ██████████ backed the vehicle into the driveway at which time everybody got out of the vehicle and went around the back of the house. Shortly thereafter they all came running around from the back of the house and ██████████ drove them away from the house. It was at this time they realized they had forgotten ██████████ and ██████████ was subsequently picked up on Wiles Road while holding a TV.

██████████ then drove to the residence in Coconut Creek as ██████████ allegedly told him that his QB lived there. On arrival, ██████████ knocked on the door and Dorsey exited the vehicle to go around the back. They then all came running back screaming "Gun" and jumped in the car as ██████████ drove off. As they were leaving this area they were subsequently stopped by marked Coconut Creek Police units on Winston park Boulevard.

The DVD statements were submitted into evidence at the conclusion of the interview.

On 11/30/07 I responded to the area of Winston Park Blvd. and Winston Park Blvd. N. in reference to a suspicious vehicle. Upon arrival I met with Sgt. K. Markland and Ofc. D. Noordeloos who had conducted a felony traffic stop on a [REDACTED] Honda Civic occupied by five black males. The vehicle was registered to Michael [REDACTED]. The vehicle had been stopped after a call for service (9:39 AM) was received about the vehicle appearing suspicious. Information had also been received that some of the occupants in the vehicle were observed to be wearing gloves. The complainant, K. Rohloff reported the occupants appeared to be "casing" the area. The males had been detained pending further investigation. The male occupants in the vehicle were identified as follows:

I made contact with [REDACTED] and Dorsey who were sitting on the median in handcuffs. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had been placed in patrol units. Investigation revealed that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were on probation for burglary.

As Ofc. Noordeloos conducted the traffic stop on the individuals, victim [REDACTED] contacted 9-1-1 in reference to a residential burglary at his home. Ofc. Ku therefore responded to [REDACTED] home located 5512 NW 41st Ave. Upon Ku's arrival, [REDACTED] reported that three black males had entered his home through the rear slider. He reported the males were in a black BMW.

After being notified by Ofc. Ku of his findings, I responded to [REDACTED] home. Upon arrival at the home, [REDACTED] told me that at approximately 9:40 AM, he observed a large/heavy set black male ringing his door bell. He also observed a black vehicle backed into his driveway. [REDACTED] stated he did not recognize the male and therefore did not open the door. Several minutes later, [REDACTED] walked out of his bedroom and observed several black males in his living room. [REDACTED] yelled out "what are you doing," as the males fled via the smashed rear slider. After the males exited the rear slider, the males ran toward the southside of the house and went around to the front. The males then entered the vehicle on the driveway and sped away. [REDACTED] stated he was in fear for his life when he observed the males in his living room, but was able to get a good look at two of the suspects. [REDACTED] proceeded to describe the male that rang the door bell as a "pudgy" black male, approximately 5'8-5'10 weighing approximately 200 lbs. He described the second male as a tall and slender black male who was wearing a gray hooded sweat shirt. From my previous contact with the males, I determined that two of the males that had been detained by Ofc. Noordeloos matched the description of the suspects given to me by [REDACTED]. A show up with the males was therefore conducted with the males detained by Ofc. Noordeloos. Upon conducting the show-up, [REDACTED] positively identified [REDACTED] (AKA "Parkway") as the male that rang his door bell prior to the his burglary. [REDACTED] also positively identified Demar Dorsey as the male he had seen inside his living room a few minutes prior. After the show-up was conducted, [REDACTED] provided a sworn

taped recorded statement of the incident. The statement was taken into property as 07-1955. [REDACTED] stated he wished to prosecute the males for entering his home without permission and smashing his rear slider.

While still at [REDACTED]'s home, I made contact with Ofc. Ku. Ku was processing [REDACTED] home and discovered a Nike flip flop left by one of the suspects on the southside of the residence. It was later determined that the matching slipper was located inside [REDACTED]'s vehicle and had been left by [REDACTED] as he fled [REDACTED] home. The slipper was taken into evidence by Ofc. Ku.

Investigation also later revealed the Black BMW observed by [REDACTED] was witness, [REDACTED] was driving by [REDACTED] home when the incident took place and reported seeing the males wearing gloves as he passed the males. [REDACTED] was found to have no involvement in this crime. This was later later confirmed by the suspects themselves.

After the show-up was conducted, all five males were arrested and transported to Coconut Creek Police for interviews. Sgt. Leonard and I interviewed all the males who were read Miranda warnings. All the males acknowledged and signed the warnings and agreed to provide statements of the incident. All the juveniles declined to have their parents present during their interviews, except Dorsey who requested to call his mother. After speaking to his mother, Dorsey also gave a statement of the incident.

[REDACTED] [REDACTED] was the first suspect interviewed. During his statement, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] provided information implicating himself and all four other males as the subjects who committed a residential burglary in Coral Springs in the early morning hours of 11/30/07. In a search incident to arrest, property recovered in the trunk of the [REDACTED] Honda Civic (owned by [REDACTED] was confirmed to have been stolen from a residence in Coral Springs (Coral Springs Case 07-10366). Contact was made with Coral Springs Police and Det. J. Walters subsequently responded to the Coconut Creek Police Department.

During their interviews, [REDACTED] Dorsey, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] acknowledged their participation in the Coral Springs burglary along with the burglary of [REDACTED] home. More specifically, [REDACTED] stated he grabbed the TV in the Coral Springs burglary because "he had touched it without gloves." During [REDACTED]'s interview, [REDACTED] denied knowing the males were committing burglaries when he drove them to the locations, and stated he was only driving because [REDACTED] had a permit. However, [REDACTED] acknowledged backing the car up into both driveways of the two homes. [REDACTED] also acknowledged seeing [REDACTED] run from the home in Coral Springs and place the stolen TV in the Honda's trunk prior to driving to [REDACTED] home in Coconut Creek. See Sgt. Leonard's supplement for further details of interview.

After interviewing the males, the male's interviews (which were DVD recorded) were taken into evidence as 07-1953. The interviews were later turned over to the property clerk.

All the male's Miranda forms were taken into evidence as property 07-1956 and turned over to the drop safe. [REDACTED]'s audio taped confession was taken into evidence as 07-1954 and turned over to the felony locker.

After interviewing the males, I made contact with Ofc. Noordeloos who was processing the males inside the city jail. During such process, I inspected all the male's shoes. Upon looking at Dorsey's, [REDACTED]'s, and [REDACTED]'s shoes, I observed broken glass pieces on the shoe's soles. Photographs of the shoes were taken and turned over to records.

No further action taken on this date.
