Report Summary:

Coach Ejection - AA Huron Head Coach Cory Gildersleeve The incidents involving this contest span over 8 reports. This report is Part 2 of 8. After the end of the 4th period, during the period of official's jurisdiction outlined in NFHS Rule 1.1.3. Coach Gildersleeve, approached Coach Test (AA Planner HC) and accused

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him for throwing deep passes late in game while the score was already lop-sided in Pioneer's favor. While engaged in the hand shake, Coach Gildersleeve continued shouting in Coach Test's face and would not release his hand. The word "fvok" was heard at least twice by officials in his verbal abuse of his opposing coach, as he was physically moving Coach Test backwards. He continued this action, despite an official intervening and attempting to separate the coaches. His actions were the direct cause of a retaliatory push by a Pioneer assistant coach and the start of a fight involving dozens of players, coaches, and spectators on the playing field. Coach Gildersleeve was ejected for flagrant unsportsmanlike conduct.

Comments Regarding this Report:

Coach Gildersleeve did not push Coach Test backwards. Both were engaged and shouting at one another. I was also at midfield and heard the entire conversation. The conversation had just ended and all of a sudden, a Pioneer assistant coach jumped the back of Coach Gildersleeve. No official tried to break this conversation up. The Pioneer assistant charged us from 45 feet away and that's when all the pushing and shoving began. One football player from Huron had 5 stitches in his face as a result of a kick as he was on the ground. This was cleared up within one and a half minutes as it only involved coaches and players. Most spectators had already left the contest as the game was well in hand for Pioneer. No spectators rushed the field as our locks were secured on the fence. Order was restored within 1 1/2 minutes.
