Prior to the end of the 4th period, with 0:10 seconds left on the clock, Huron [REDACTED] began verbally taunting opponents with profanity and had to be restrained by officials. When he was directed to return to the same area by two officials, he threw his helmet at the feet of the Head Linesman and exclaimed "Fuck it, screw me out, they're a bunch of niggers!" For this action, he was ejected for flagrant unsportsmanlike conduct.

After the end of the 4th period, during the period of official's jurisdiction defined in NFHS Rule 1.1.8, Coach Gildersleeve, approached Coach Test (AA Pioneer HC) and accosted

...continued shouting in Coach Test's face and would not release his hand. The word "fuck" was heard at least twice by officials in his verbal abuse of his opposing coach, as he was physically moving Coach Test backwards. He continued this action, despite an official intervening and attempting to separate the coaches. His actions were the direct cause of a retaliatory push by a Pioneer assistant coach and the start of a fight involving dozens of players, coaches, and spectators on the playing field. Coach Gildersleeve was ejected for flagrant unsportsmanlike conduct.

Coach Ejection - AA Pioneer Asst. Coach (to be named) The incidents involving this contest span over 8 reports. This report is Part 3 of 8. During the events described in the AA Huron Head Coach ejection report (Report 2 of 8), this assistant coach, in response to the verbal exchange and the forcing of Coach Test (Pioneer) to move backwards by the advancing Coach Gildersleeve (Huron), shoved Coach Gildersleeve with two hands, which prompted a response by the Coaches and players from both teams. Immediately following this action, a large fight broke out involving dozens of players, coaches, bench personnel, and spectators. The AA Pioneer Assistant Coach was Ejected for flagrant unsportsmanlike conduct and violent conduct.

Coach Ejection - AA Pioneer Head Coach Paul Test The incidents involving this contest span over 8 reports. This report is Part 5 of 8. Immediately following the events described in Reports (1 through 4), Coach Test was unable to prevent uncountable acts of fighting and flagrant unsportsmanlike conduct. These acts include, but are not limited to, (1) his assistant coach instigating a fight by pushing the Huron Head Coach, (2) numerous players and coaches on his staff engaged in fighting, and (3) a person entering the field from his bench using a medical crutch as a weapon to strike an unidentified person. For his lack of control of players and bench personnel, Coach Test was ejected for flagrant unsportsmanlike conduct.

Sportsmanship Report – AA Pioneer The incidents involving this contest span over 8 reports. This report is Part 6 of 8. The following acts contributed at least in part to a post-game fight on the field that resulted in at least one hospitalization and police action. During the game, there were several penalties (both dead ball personal fouls and unsportsmanlike conduct) committed by Pioneer for acts that exceeded the conduct threshold for interscholastic contests. The coaching staffs of both teams were directed repeatedly to concentrate on preventing these escalating acts by removing overly aggressive players from the game. At the end of the game (less than 2 minutes in the 4th quarter), AA Pioneer had an opportunity to end the game without inflating the already volatile situation by "running out the clock" with short running plays, or more traditionally, "taking a knee". Instead of taking this accepted and traditional approach to ending a game quietly and without incident, the play calls were all deep passes which resulted in drawing out the last few minutes of the contest in an attempt to score a final touchdown. This approach was taken as disrespectful by the Huron players and resulted in a heated verbal exchange by the Huron Head Coach Cory Gildersleeve across the field with his opponent Pioneer Coach Paul Test, inquiring as to the reason for the passing play calls, in which Coach Test shouted across the field "I'm playing football!" while being restrained by officials. After being confronted by an official regarding the behavior, Coach Test contradicted his previous statement stating that he "was not calling the plays that were being run, and he will now be taking a knee." It was not until Coach Test was warned by officials of the consequences of his choice in play calls, that he called a "victory formation" and instructed the quarterback to take a knee to end the game. These events led to the altercation during the post-game hand shake and eventually to the fight. These unfortunate events likely could have been avoided by simply running out the clock in the last few minutes.

Sportsmanship Report - AA Huron The incidents involving this contest span over 8 reports. This report is # 7 of 8. The following acts contributed at least in part to a post-game fight on the field that resulted in at least one hospitalization and police action. During the game, there were several penalties (both dead ball personal fouls and unsportsmanlike conduct) committed by Huron for acts that exceeded the conduct threshold for interscholastic contests. The coaching staffs of both teams were directed repeatedly to concentrate on preventing these escalating acts by removing overly aggressive players from the game. At end of game, as described in the AA Pioneer sportsmanship report (Part 6 of 6), Pioneer was passing ball in the last few minutes of the 4th quarter rather than running the ball to swiftly end the game. The Huron coaches and players took the act as a disrespectful one (i.e. trying to unnecessarily run up the score, deny an opportunity to end the game). The Huron coaching staff responded by shouting inflammatory remarks across the field at the Pioneer coaching staff who also responded. Most notably, the Huron Head Coach Cory Gildersleeve screamed "[Coach] Test! What the fuck is that!" after a deep pass play towards end zone. Coach Gildersleeve had to be restrained by officials and fellow coaches and told repeatedly to stop shouting unsportsmanlike language across the field.

Other Ejection - Unknown AA Pioneer Bench Personnel The incidents involving this contest span over 8 reports. This report is Part 8 of 8. During the fight involving players, coaches, and spectators from both Huron and Pioneer, this sideline individual left the bench area and became involved in the fight. This person was witnessed by an official using his crutch as a weapon by striking an unidentified person, breaking the crutch. He was secured by the official and turned over an Ann Arbor police officer who was responding to the incident.
