Harbaugh added a much needed dimension to Pioneer's attack with his passing. The sophomore completed seven passes which helped offset the Pioneers' struggling ground game. Harbaugh had seen his first varsity action last week although he didn't start.

Campbell made the game safe when he shocked the crowd in Withington Stadium by chasing down Terry L. Thomas on a sweep, snatching the ball from his arms, spinning toward the opposite goal line and romping 45 yards to score. Harbaugh passed to Rowry for the conversion, making it 14-0.

Pioneer is 1-0 in the conference and hosts powerhouse Adrian next week. The Pioneers are 2-3 overall. Parkside is 0-1 in the league and 2-3 overall.

Following Campbell's touchdown, Pioneer's defense chased down Thomas for a 15-yard loss and forced a quick kick forty yards away. Pioneer used six plays to score. The key play was a 22-yard completion from Harbaugh to Bubba Green. Three plays later, Tom Hill plunged in for the final score of the half.

Harbaugh and Green were part of a redesigned backfield used to shake up the team. Harbaugh replaced John Minick at quarterback with Minick moving to fullback. Green started at tailback, moving Tracy French to split end. Hill was replaced as starting fullback but came back with a solid game.
