Tickets:

Public Ticket Sales:

\$75 sales at Gate G on game day – *if available.*

Student Tickets:

\$45 with MSU Student ID, maximum number of 2; reserved seat outside Student Section (**no seating available *within* the student section**).

Ages:

EVERYONE REGARDLESS OF AGE MUST HAVE A TICKET.

Ticket Issues:

Guest Services window West side of stadium between Gates G & H

Persons with Disabilities:

Entrance is through the north end gates. Shuttle bus to designated parking lot (Lot 48- Natural Resources) accessed from north end gates. Ramps are ADA compliant and built to the latest code.

Special:

Fly over at 11:56am. Handing out “Go Green/Go White” signs at all gates but Gate B (student gate).

PARKING:

On campus public parking is available for \$20 per game and is located at Munn Field (alcohol free), lots north of the railroad tracks are \$15 and lots south of the railroad tracks are \$10. For more information, contact MSU Police Department at 517-355-8440.

NOTE: All parking locations will open at 7AM for this game.

SHUTTLE/BUS:

Available from Lot 89 at the corner of Mt. Hope Road and Farm Lane. The shuttle starts two hours before the game and returns for a reasonable amount of time after the game. The cost is \$4 per game for a round trip ticket or \$28 for a season pass. Parking in this lot is free.

GATES OPEN:

Public gates open 1 ½ hours before game time. Student gate (B), Spartan Club (gate E) and Suites (gate E) open 2 hours before game time. Media gate (gate F) opens 3 hours before game time.

Stadium Regulations and Other Pertinent Information

- No seatbacks
- NO BAGS OR PURSES**
- No containers of any kind
- No noisemakers
- No smoking
- No strollers
- No food or drink (1 sealed bottle per fan; maximum – 20 oz.)
- No alcohol
- No cameras or radios larger than 5 ½ x 8 ½ x 2
- No cases, video cameras
- No banners or signs
- No umbrellas
- No oversized hats
- No seat cushions with pouches or pockets

- **NO BAGS or PURSES.** IF IT LOOKS LIKE A BAG AND IS CARRIED LIKE A BAG, IT IS A BAG!
- No bags or purses are allowed inside Spartan Stadium. This includes but not limited to: no backpacks, purses of any size, camera cases, binocular cases, wallets not stored in pockets, bags, diaper bags, seat cushions with pockets that are used for storage. If any of these bags are attached to a person's waist or wrist, they are still not allowed in. Bags/purses are not allowed in!
- There is no longer a "Family Needs" entrance (diaper bags are no longer allowed in at this gate or any other gate). Gates C and K are only for those individuals with true medical needs. Those individuals entering at those gates may bring the medical items in any bag. Those bags will be searched and tagged by an MSU Police Officer. The officer working that gate has the final determination if that item is a true medical need.
- Those individuals that need to bring in items that cannot fit into a pocket (camera, sunscreen, diapers, etc.) may bring those items in a clear, one gallon size container.
- Clear, one gallon size containers may come in at any gate and may be subject to search.
- This policy also applies to all volunteers and employees coming thru.
- Bags and purses will be allowed in the tower but they will all be searched and tagged.
- Therefore, all bags that do come into Spartan Stadium (via Gates K, C or the tower) will be searched and tagged.
- There will be no provisions for checking and/or holding items deemed inappropriate. Restricted items, bags and purses may not be left at or around the gates. **Items left unattended will be removed and discarded.**
- Those individuals working gates SHOULD NOT tell patrons to hide items in the bushes as these will cause enhanced police response due to threats from suspicious .

WHY IS SPARTAN STADIUM NO LONGER ALLOWING BAGS OR PURSES?

The no-bag/no-purse policy is one of many changes being made to Spartan Stadium to increase the safety and security of the venue. Many of the changes being made are "behind the scenes" and not visible to the public. In addition to the added safety, the new no-bag/no-purse policy will allow for quicker entry into the stadium and more room in the seating areas.

ATM – within stadium gates, lower level- behind section 25; outside stadium gates, SW corner of Spartan Stadium by the track, the library, and the International Center.

Concessions – Visa and Master Cards accepted at ALL stands. Spartan Cash accepted in the south east corner (Sections 10, 11, 12, 13, 112).

Elevators – Gate F for press & elevator passes, Gate E for suite & club ticket holders. Day passes - Guest Services window.

First Aid – East concourse - opposite section 7; West concourse- opposite section 20; Upper West concourse - next to section 123.

Guest Services – Outside Stadium – (west) Gates G & H. Inside stadium West concourse - opposite section 23. Wristbands for parents to write phone numbers and seat locations will be provided at Guest Services.

Information Kiosks – Located at Gates B, C, D, G, J, K.

Lost and Found items – Gate G – Stadium Staffing room, 1 hour after the game contact MSU Police at 517.355.2222.

Persons with Disabilities Parking - Located in Lot 48, behind the Natural Resources building, enter from Trowbridge extension of Red Cedar or Farm Lane. \$15 per game paid upon entering lot. Shuttle running to Northeast corner of the stadium. Shuttle runs from 2 hours before the game, throughout the game and a reasonable time after the game.

Police – East concourse - opposite section 9.

Programs – Available for purchase inside and outside Spartan Stadium.

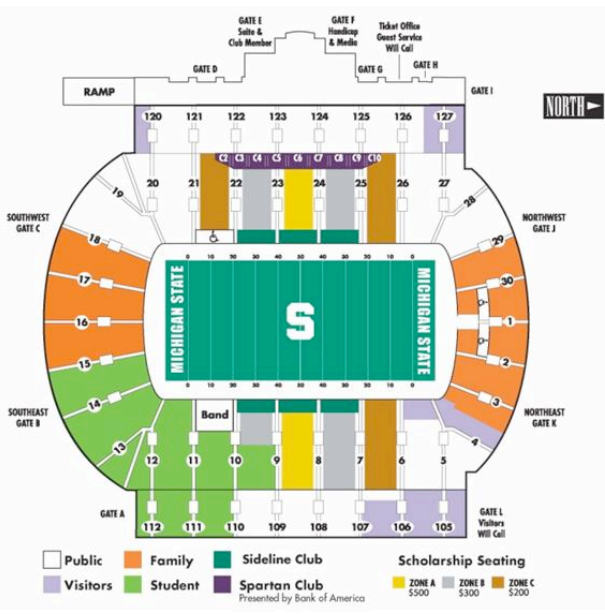
