§ 1: Private Religious or Seasonal Events on City Property

- A. A private individual, group, or entity may use city property to conduct a religious or seasonal event, subject to reasonable time, place, and manner regulations, if—
 - 1. the city property in question is a traditional public forum, such as a sidewalk, park, or plaza;
 - 2. the city property in question is a designated or limited public forum, such as a government building, community center, or other city-owned facility, where the city has permitted a wide variety of expressive conduct
- B. A reasonable restriction under Subsection (A) must be justified without reference to the content or message of the event.

§ 2: City Events on City Property

The city may present or sponsor the presentation of a seasonal or holiday event if the overall message of the display is not primarily religious.
