


Washtenaw County: Police staffing vs. arrests

Drunken-driving arrests declined statewide in recent years, as police manpower also dropped. But trends from city to city can vary widely. Here's a look at police and arrest totals for 2006, 2011, and 2012, and where the agency ranks against others in arrests per officer.
