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

²Hetero, high risk = Heterosexual sex with IDU, known HIV+ partner, bisexual male, sex worker etc. ³Hetero, low risk = Heterosexual sex with no other risk identified

Note: Risk percentages are calculated in relation to the total number of cases. Risk percentages may add up to more or less than 100% due to some individuals having more than one risk and others having none identified.
