

Pioneer's defense held on the first series of downs and got the ball back on its own 38. On the first play from scrimmage, Harbaugh hit Floyd Rowry with a 62 yard scoring pass to build the lead to three touchdowns.

Before the final Pioneer score, Viking fullback Jim Summerour took over, gaining huge chunks of yardage up the middle and scoring two touchdowns to make the game close. He finished with 124 yards rushing, all of them in the second half.

Harbaugh hit Tim Michalik with a 43 yard pass to score Pioneer's last touchdown with 4:54 left in the game.

Jackson dominated the rushing and the first down statistics, but Harbaugh's passing made the difference in the game. He connected on five-of-nine for 152 yards to offset a 193-103 deficit on the ground and a 16-10 Jackson dominance of first downs.

"We got a victory," said Ritter, "and I think we will be ready mentally to play next week against Huron."
