Pioneers call shots to beat Huron, 20-8

Three periods of domination were more than enough for Pioneer High Friday.

Paced by the pounding of Tom Hill, scampering of Bubba Green and accuracy of Jim Harbaugh, the Pioneers thoroughly mastered Huron 20-8 at Hollway Field in the football season wrapup.
