If the winner chooses the Home Audit or insulation prizes conditions listed below apply in order to provide transparency as required by the EECBG grant:

Home Emergy Audit Prize (\$500 Value)

- Audit must be performed before January 15, 2010 by an auditor certified by or registered with the Building Performance Institute (BPI) or Residential Energy Services Network (RESNET) or Energy Star certified Energy Auditor. Proof of certification or registration must be supplied.
- A copy of the signed original completed audit will be provided by the auditor to Pittsfield Township. 3. A written follow-up report by the winner describing the insights gained is required within 2 weeks of audit.
- 4. The report must identify improvements the winner is planning to implement as a result of the audit, along with an estimated time line for completion.
- All identifying information will be kept private and confidential.
 The auditor chosen must comply with Pittsfield Charter Township contractor requirements.

Home Insulation prize (\$500)

- Determine the type of insulation you need for your home and we will prepay the Pittsfield Township store you purchase it from.
 Photo documentation of area (i.e. attic) before and after the insulation improvement
 All insulation must be installed before January 15, 2011.
 Winner must provide utility bills from January, February and March of 2010 and the same months in 2011 to provide comparative documentation of reduced heating costs due to improved insulation.
